MONTREAL COMICCON CELEBRATES ITS 10TH ANNIVERSARY ON A GRAND SCALE!

Montreal (Quebec), March 27, 2018 – From July 6 to 8, Montreal Comiccon and its army of devoted fans will once again take by storm the halls of Palais de congrès. This year, though, the occasion will be momentous, as the epic pop culture gathering will celebrate its 10th anniversary with a program for the ages.

It was 10 years ago that a small band of comic book misfits rented a modest meeting room to exchange ideas and trade books, toys, movies, and all kinds of fantasy fiction paraphernalia. A decade later, Montreal Comiccon is expected to host over 60,000 attendees from Canada and abroad, dozens of star guests, hundreds of exhibitors, and a calendar of activities to keep someone awake for three days straight. Over the course of a decade, the event, which celebrates the worlds of science fiction, fantasy, anime, horror, video games, and, of course comics, has grown to become one of Montreal's most beloved cultural happenings.

ENTERTAINMENT & COMIC BOOK GUESTS

The X-Files is one of the greatest science fiction and supernatural franchises of all-time. The show, which premiered in 1993, pushed the boundaries of serialized TV fiction, thrilled fans, and influenced a generation of writers, directors, and actors. To mark its 10th anniversary, Montreal Comiccon is proud to welcome the stars of *The X-Files*, **David Duchovny** and **Gillian Anderson**. After skyrocketing to fame with their portrayals of agents Mulder and Scully, Duchovny and Anderson went on to appear separately in several hit TV shows, including the Emmy-winning *Californication*, *Aguarius*, *The Fall*, *Hannibal*, and *American Gods*, before making a glorious return to *The X-Files* in 2016.

Duchovny and Anderson will be joined by the most beloved bad boy of the silver screen, the dangerous (yet very-kind-in-person) **Danny Trejo**. Trejo's unforgettable performances in Robert Rodriguez' films, *Desperado* (1995), *From Dusk Till Dawn* (1996), and *Spy Kids* (2001) ensured his spot in the villains Hall of Fame, before getting his turn as an antiheroic leading man in the ultra-violent theatrical hit, *Machete* (2010), and in its equally ruthless sequel, *Machete Kills* (2013). Other big and small screen names in attendance include the martial artist, actor and pop culture icon **Chuck Norris**, mostly known for his starring roles in action films like *Delta Force* and *Missing in Action*, as well as in the TV series *Walker, Texas Ranger*; **Jennifer Morrison**, known for her roles as Dr. Allison Cameron in the medical-drama, *House*, and as Emma Swan in the ABC adventure-fantasy series, *Once Upon a Time*; **Mark Sheppard**, from the horror drama, *Supernatural*, and the 2005 space epic, *Battlestar Galactica*; **Pom Klementieff**, the French actress behind the role of Mantis in *Guardians of the Galaxy Vol.* 2 and in the upcoming, *Avengers: Infinity War* (2018); and **Amanda Tapping**, the Canadian actress and director, recognized as Samantha Carter on *Stargate SG-1* and *Stargate Atlantis*, and as Helen Magnus on *Sanctuary*. **Adrian Paul**, the British actor and choreographer famous for his role as Duncan MacLeod, in *Highlander: The Series*, will host **The Sword Experience**, a three-and-half-hour sword-training seminar, featuring stage and real-life combat tips for fans, actors, martial artists, and role-playing groups.

In addition to TV and film stars, Montreal Comiccon always has a special place for the incredibly gifted actors who lend their voices to cartoon, anime, and video game characters. This year, fans will meet the entire leading cast of the hit web series, RWBY, including **Lindsay Jones** (Ruby Rose), **Kara Eberle** (Weiss Schnee), **Barbara Dunkelman** (Yang Xiao Long), **Arryn Zech** (Blake Belladona), and **Michael Jones** (Sun Wukong).

True to its name, Montreal Comiccon will roll the red carpet once again for legends and rising stars of the comic book world. Attending the 10th edition will be **Gerry Conway**, the mighty scriptwriter behind some of Marvel's and DC's most powerful moments, including the traumatic death of Gwen Stacy in *The Amazing Spider-Man*, and the introduction of Frank Castle, a.k.a. The Punisher; **Larry Hama**, the brilliant writing force behind Hasbro's *G.I. Joe: A Real American Hero* toy line, and its Marvel Comics series from 1982 to 1994; **David Lloyd**, the co-creator of the landmark graphic novel, *V for Vendetta*; and **Neal Adams**, the artist who propelled American comics into gritty adult themes with his realistic

renditions of Batman, The X-Men, and Green Arrow. They will be joined by a myriad of artists from every corner of the comic book universe, including **Dan Parent** (Archie Comics), **Danica Brine** (Wayward), **Gautier Langevin** (Far Out), **Gisèle Lagacé** (Jem and the Holograms), **Jeik Dion** (Turbo Kid: Skeletron Unleashed), **Ken Lashley** (Suicide Squad), **Nick Brasdshaw** (Guardians of the Galaxy), **Olivier Carpentier** (Far Out), **Yanick Paquette** (Wonder Woman: Earth One), **John Tyler Christopher** (Star Wars), and **Michael Cho** (The Flash: The Silver Age).

MAIN ATTRACTIONS

Montreal Comiccon will present a calendar packed with over 150 panels, workshops, concerts, improv performances, board games, screenings, autograph sessions, and photo ops. There will be anime-themed contests and insightful master classes with comic book creators. The widely popular **Family Zone** will offer energy-burning activities for those 12 and under, including laser sword training and Nerf battles.

There will be more video game entertainment than ever. Gaming worlds will come to life in the 5th floor freeplay area, presented in partnership with DreamHack. Loto-Québec and Multijoueur will join forces in the Indie Game Zone, where close to 40 talented Québec studios will unveil their new creations. And nostalgic video game fans of all ages will go back to the future in the Retro Gaming Area, featuring games and consoles from the past four decades.

THE MUSIC OF COMICCON

Music is always at the forefront of Montreal Comiccon, with an ever-growing program of live performances. The Film Music Wind Orchestra (*OVMF - L'Orchestre à vents de musiques de films*), 50 classical musicians under the direction of conductor and arranger, Jocelyn Leblanc, will delight fans with soundtracks of their favourite films and video games, including *Star Wars* (Friday, July 6), *A Universe of Video Games* (Saturday, July 7), and *Harry Potter* (Sunday, July 8). On Saturday July 8, at 8:00 p.m., Montreal Comiccon in collaboration with Shank Events will bring back **Nerdstock**, a 7th floor festival of nerdy rock bands, featuring headliners **Cybertronic Spree**, a hair metal band of robots-in-disguise that bangs out music from *Transformers: The Movie*; **Jardin Mécanique**, a steampunk musical trio; **Skieur Fluo**, a geek culture-inspired pop, punk and metal act; and **Billy & the Fox**, a narrative conceptual band. Lastly, **House of M Productions** will pay homage to *Buffy the Vampire Slayer* with live musical recreations of popular episodes.

To add to the fun, Montreal Comiccon is delighted to announce a first collaboration with Microbrasserie Dieu du ciel! on a special brew that will be exclusively available at the event.

Montreal Comiccon will occupy the entirety of Palais des congrès and run from Friday, July 6 to Sunday, July 8, 2018. Tickets are now available, including single day and three-day tickets, special Deluxe and VIP packages, student-priced Friday tickets, and Sunday Family packages. **Nerdstock** and **The Sword Experience** tickets go on sale Tuesday, March 27 at 1:00 p.m. Please visit www.montrealcomiccon.com for details and updates, as more guests and activities will be added to the roster in the months leading up to the event.
